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## SCHOLARSHIPS AT MELBOURNE HIGH SCHOOL

Melbourne High School does not offer scholarship places prior to confirmation of acceptance of offer of places. The School does however offer a range of scholarships and prizes at each Year Level. Information about these scholarships is available by contacting the Registrar's Office on <u>enrol@mhs.vic.edu.au</u>

Each year there is one scholarship to be awarded to one incoming Year 9 student. The *Lindsay Fox Scholarship* is awarded each year to a commencing Year 9 student to support the costs of his education at Melbourne High School. The criteria for selection are:

- 1. The students must have a parent, or parents who have either a Commonwealth Health Care Card or a Pension Card, and who qualify for income support benefits. Certified evidence will be required to prove eligibility.
- 2. The student is to submit a written application detailing his capacity to contribute positively to the broad academic and co-curricular programmes of the School.
- 3. Continuation of the award in consequent years is contingent upon satisfactory academic progress, continuing co-curricular involvement and continued eligibility for a Commonwealth Health Care Card or Pension Card, or in the case of a student aged 16 years and over, eligibility for the Commonwealth Youth Allowance Scheme.

Selection for the scholarship is conducted by the School's Scholarship Committee, under the direction of the Principal. The decision of the Principal is final and is not subject to appeal.

The annual provision to the scholarship holder will be \$3000 per annum. This will be accessed as a credit through the School Business Manager against the costs of school charges, books, uniforms and other school requisites. The scholarship will not involve access to cash. This ensures that the monies are used for their intended purpose.

To apply for this scholarship, eligible students are to complete the enclosed application form and submit it to the Registrar's Office. Certified evidence of Commonwealth Health Care Card or Pension Card eligibility must accompany the application.
